

Completion and Promotion Data

Graduation Alliance calculates data in calendar years. The aggregate course completion and promotion data for the Florida VIP program is presented below by subgroup for the school year beginning July 1, 2025-June 30, 2026.

Student completion calculations include all students who are enrolled for more than 14 days in a course.

Course Completion Rates, Aggregate and by Subgroups

The methodology for calculating course completion rates is all courses completed with a D or better/ all courses completed. Courses taken more than one time were counted once.

Successful Course Completion Rates, Aggregate and by Subgroups

The methodology for calculating successful course completion rates is all courses completed with a D or better / all courses completed with a D or better + all courses completed with no credit.

Promotion Rates, Aggregate and by Subgroups

It should be noted that grade levels are an artificial construct for Graduation Alliance programs which focus on re-engaging former dropouts in their education and helping them work toward graduation. We work with students who have been out of school for as much as three or four years prior to returning through our district-run dropout recovery programs. The ultimate goal for them and for us is graduation.

Promotion to a higher grade level is largely geared toward students in grades K-8, whereas Graduation Alliance works with students in grades 9-12. Therefore, the course completion data above is our best indicator of student achievement and progress. Graduation Alliance does not collect promotion data, per se.
